The 14th edition of IFKAD - International Forum on Knowledge Asset Dynamics was held in Matera from 5^{th} to 7^{th} June 2019. The mission of IFKAD is the development of research and scientific conversations aimed at contributing to theroy-building as well as to the managerial practice about the role of knowledge as an organisational value-drive source.

In this context, iBLUE results were presented and described, strengthening the linkages among **thory-building** and managerial **practice**.

In particular, the process of the creation of the new methodology by integrating the sustainable pillars (i.e., economic, environmental and social) in the concept of business model innovation was presented. The creation process articulates in three steps:

- 1. the literature review on business model innovation;
- 2. the collection of the sustainable best practices;
- 3. the case studies analysis.

As result, it has been possible to outline the 3-PBM (3-Pillar Business Model) methodology, a collection of tools and methods for the application of business models suitable for enterprises in the yachting sector of Mediterranean area.

Organized in the framework of the international research, almost 300 participants from across the world attended IFKAD conference, included researchers, associated and full professors.

ISPIM's annual innovation conference took place in Florence from 16th ot 19th June. The conference theme was "Celebrating Innovation: 500 Years since Da Vinci" and attracted around 550 innovation professionals from academia, industry, consulting and the public sector from around 50 countries worldwide.

During the conference, iBLUE project **testing phase** through **pilot actions** was presented. 3-PBM methodology was applied to SMEs and it helps the companies, participating in the pilot actions, to get additional perspectives on their business, to deepen the understanding of business model mechanics, to holistically manage their impact, in terms of reducing negative impact and leveraging positive impact, and to improve the overall economic performance and competitiveness.

Feedback was collected about the methodology and the benefit of iBLUE findings for the innovation community, especially in terms of contribution to the theory, as well as practical implications. Through the presentation we gathered information about 3-PBM methodology's strength points, weaknesses, usability and problems. This information will be used to define changes and refinements to apply to the methodology in order to improve it.
