Methodology Training in
Limassol

The 8th Steering Committee meeting took place on the 18th September 2019 in Limassol - Cyprus. CCCI – Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry was the hosting partner. The event was held in a comfortable meeting room at the Crown Plaza Limassol Hotel.

The Steering Committee was launched by CCCI: Demetra Palaonda, welcomed all partners; UNIUD, as Lead Partner, presented the aim of the event.

MORNING SESSION.

During the morning session the activities regarding WP4 Testing and WP5 Transferring were faced.

The WP4 Testing was initially introduced to check the numbers of reports on pilot action delivered to RCDI, responsible partner of activity 4.4.

Three other deliverables referring to WP4 were analysed during the morning session: D.4.5.1, D.4.5.2 and D.4.5.3.

D.4.5.1 “Evaluation tool for pilot activities”: the objective is to collect the questionnaires in order to analyse the data contained in it and more specifically identify two different averages: one coming from the responses of SMEs and one from the answers of the consortium.

The other two deliverables considered were D.4.5.2 “Report about 3-PBM refinement proposals” and D.4.5.3 “Report about indicators system implementation”. On this occasion, STEPRI presented a document that provide indications for the improvement of the sustainability indicators.

Concerning WP5 Transferring, UNIUD, as responsible partner of D5.2.1 “Policy protocol about iBLUE transferability” and D5.2.2 “Plan for results portability”, showed the progress and the current state of these deliverables in order to finalize them.

The second morning session was introduced by CCSEV explaining D.5.3.1 “Transnational network of Med yachting stakeholders”. The idea is to create a LinkedIn group in which different actors and cluster involved in the project will take part and additionally will be open to all interested parties.

Afterwards, KEDGE BS presented D.5.4.1 “Training course for the methodology application” explaining the structure of the tool box for the methodology session and the scope of this box that will be an important part of this deliverable. In addition, it was done a recap on D.5.5.1 “Focused training materials for SMEs, tourists and policy makers”, in order to receive feedbacks from partners and finalize it.

AFTERNOON SESSION.
